

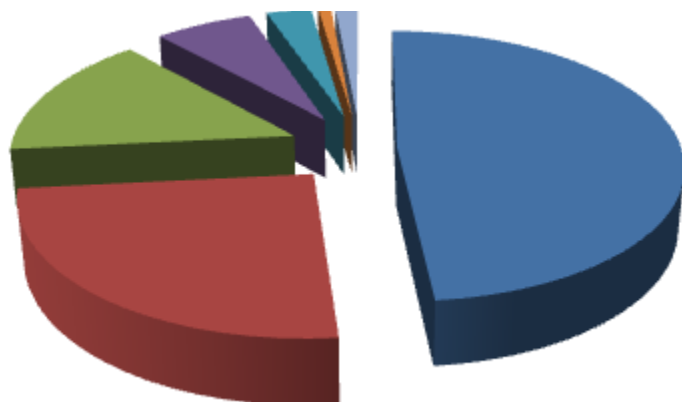

### 2011 Income: \$1,898,308 MXN\*

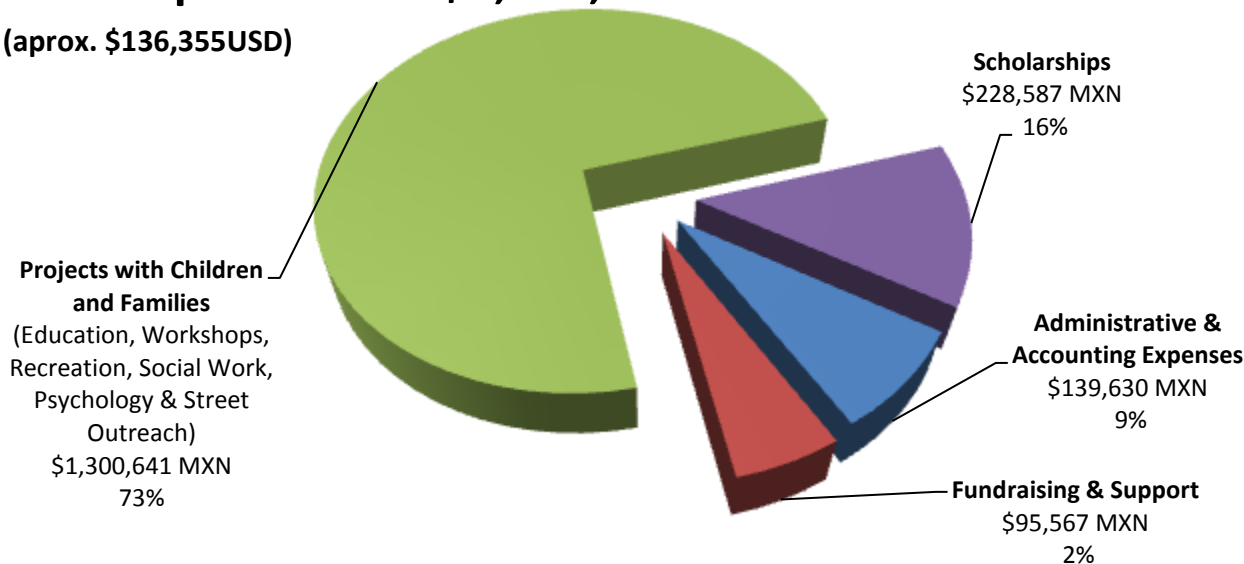

Throughout 2011, CODENI continued to grow, serving more than 100 children in programs at Casa CODENI and 40 more child laborers through our Street Outreach program with evening activities in *Plaza Liberación* in downtown Guadalajara. The education area also evolved to offer reading and writing workshops in our new library. Above all, we increased our efforts with the teenagers in CODENI, thanks to a grant from the federal government for our new program "Teen Life Projects". We closed the year with the dreams of 50

adolescents formalized as goals for 2012 and their commitment to accomplish them with the support of CODENI.

CODENI continued to experience many transitions in the staff due primarily to low salaries; however we finally achieved our goal of providing health care and benefits to CODENI employees. We begin 2012 with a fulltime fundraiser on staff and hopes of forming a team of educators who will dedicate many years to come with our children, teens and families.

With the generous donations in response to our end of the year campaign, Casa CODENI has a new roof over the central patio and new stairs to connect the recreation area with the education and workshops classrooms. We also have a fresh coat of paint on Casa CODENI, thanks to a team of volunteers from HP. We are anticipating great accomplishments in 2012 throughout the CODENI community of families, volunteers, staff and benefactors.
