




2013 Annual Report

With a strong commitment to our values of transparency, confidence and cooperation, the CODENI bus continues to transport dozens of families off the streets and out of poverty.

Income 2013



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EDUCATION

The majority of our adolescents now have the highest level of education in the history of their families.

Thanks to our academic support programs, the CODENI community includes 4 students in college, 14 in high school, 36 in middle school and 57 in elementary school.

Furthermore, 79 participants earned academic scholarships in CODENI due to their efforts and commitment to our programs and their formal education.



WORKSHOPS



In Círculo CODENI we held nearly 200 sessions of painting, crafts, public speaking, Hip Hop, aerial dance, reflection and empowerment workshops, in which more than 100 children and teens participated. Our singers and dancers performed in three public presentations on different stages in the state of Jalisco this year.

RECREATION

We were also blessed with the opportunity to carry out more renovations in Casa CODENI. Thanks to a grant from Grupo 100, Corporativa de Fundaciones and Vectra Forum, we were able to accomplish our dream of having a gym in CODENI. This project has enabled us to involve more teens in our programs, promoting a healthy lifestyle and preventing their involvement in gangs and other criminal activities.

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EMPOWERED MOMS

The number of participants in our parenting classes also grew to an average of 44 moms per session. These women's families also benefited from our monthly food basket program.

In addition, 16 mothers graduated from our empowerment workshops and five others began life projects off the streets this year.



PSYCHOLOGY



We received psychology students from five different universities to fulfill the social service component of their programs or work as professional interns in Casa CODENI in 2013.

Thanks to their support, 25 individuals and families participated in psychological therapies in CODENI, and 19 of these therapies were successfully concluded.

SOCIAL COMMUNICATION

This year we gave 11 public presentations, including conferences and speeches in different local, national and international forums.

CODENI was also cited in 38 newspaper articles and other press sources during 2013.

These accomplishments would not have been possible without the support and commitment of 88 volunteers from different universities, high school and the general public, all of whom demonstrated their solidarity with CODENI's mission to help families overcome their dependence on the streets.
